OCTOBER



We collaborated with **Shumpun Foundation** and conducted the My Body My Rights workshop with more than **30 Parents** of children and adolescents with autism. Shumpun Foundation works with children and adolescents with autism, learning disabilities and other developmental delays and is dedicated to forging a strong partnership with families with children with special needs.


We conducted a session on Consent, Violation of Consent, Interpersonal Relationships and Communication with **Learning By Locals**, on the **6th of October, 2021**. Learning By Locals aims to educate and empower today's youth by helping them develop personal and professional skills in addition to providing them with the right opportunities and guidance.



NOVEMBER

We collaborated with Eco Femme to support **121 adolescent girls** in the Sundarbans area. A menstrual hygiene management training program was conducted in the **Katakhali High Madrasa** on the **25th of November, 2021**. This Madrasa was located in the **Hasnabad Block, North 24 Parganas, Sunderbans**. (West Bengal, India). The girls who came from the Hingalganj Panchayat and the Sanderlabil Panchayat were divided into four groups for the training sessions. All the sessions were conducted by menstrual health facilitators from Rangeen Khidki, at the end of which a set of cloth pads from **Eco Femme** were distributed to the girls who opted for it. Each kit had 4 cloth pads, an instruction manual and an information pamphlet. A total of **113** sets of cloth pad kits were distributed to all the groups combined.

DECEMBER



We collaborated with the **Department of Panchayats and Rural Development, B.R. Ambedkar Institute of Panchayats and Rural Development, Government of West Bengal** on the **26th of November, 2021** and conducted a Menstrual Hygiene Management Session with **340** participants from various Panchayats in West Bengal. We conducted a similar session again on the **9th of December** with another **150** participants.

We collaborated with **CHOICE for Youth and Sexuality** is a non-profit organisation based out of Amsterdam and **Feminist Futures India** and conducted My Body My Rights Workshop for the Body Festival Training Program which consults young people on consent and bodily autonomy and aims to bridge the gaps. The Workshop was conducted over the span of **3** days, from **13th December to 15th December, 2021** in **Kohima, Nagaland** at Red Cross Conference Hall, near Raj Bhavan.
